#### Introduction

- 'It is important that we have clear understanding with regard to end times.'
- The 'blessed hope.' The church's belief in the return of the Lord Jesus to earth.
- At the moment of His return, an event referred too as 'the rapture' also takes place.

# 1 What Do We Mean By The Term 'Rapture?'

- The word 'rapture' is a coined word to express something taught in the Bible.
- Derived from the Latin word 'rapio' meaning 'a carrying off' or 'to carry away.'
- The resurrected saints and the living saints [4:16/17] carried away.
- · Why raptured? Answer: to meet the Lord...
- Raptured to where? 'in the clouds....in the air.'

NB. It does not say, 'carried away to heaven.'

# 2 The 'Futurists' Version Of The Rapture

- The 'Second Coming' will be in 2 stages separated by 7 years.
- During this time the believers are in heaven with the Holy Spirit.
- The unsaved left behind puzzled by the Christian's disappearance.
- At the end of the 7 years Jesus returns to earth with the believers as His escort to set up His Kingdom.

### 3 Examples Of Futurism By A Leading Futurist Author and Advocate

- Quotes are from 'The Late Great Planet Earth,' by Hal Lindsey.
- Disappearing Christians, cars suddenly without drivers.
- The author refers to this event as, 'Project Disappearance.'

## 4 The Origin Of The 'Secret Rapture' Theory

- The suggestion of a 'secret' coming of Jesus came onto the scene in 1830.
- This was via a so-called prophetic utterance by Margaret McDonald in Edward Irving's church in London.
- A secret coming followed later by a visible coming.
- Those 'left behind' to go through tribulation.
- Some embraced this 'new revelation' but others like George Muller, William Booth and CH Spurgeon rejected it.

## 6 Do The 'Thief Passages' Prove A Secret Rapture?

 Futurist say texts such as [1 Thessalonians 5:2], [Revelation 16:15] etc with the motif of a 'thief' imply secrecy.

**NB.** The eastern thief was not like our western cat burglar.

- More like a Mexican bandit and his gang of thieves and cut throats.
- · The only thing secret about Christ's coming is the time of it.
- [2 Peter 3:10] is a thief passage too with lots of noise. Hardly secret.
- A two stage 'second coming' actually implies 3 comings of Christ to earth.
- Another favourite 'Futurist' text is [1 Corinthians 15:51/52].
- It is **NOT** the return of Jesus that happens so fast it isn't seen.
- It's the 'glorification' of the believer that happens in the twinkle of an eye.
- The ungodly will see the coming of Christ for His church and their rapture.

# Danger

- Some are being told if they are not saved at Jesus' rapture of the church, they can be saved during the 7 years.
- This is a false hope. The opportunity of salvation ends with the coming of Christ.
- · Now is the accepted time.
